NAKED FACES was founded in 2009 by partners Andrew Barchilon and Kitao Sakurai. Based in New York, Naked Faces focuses on developing and producing new visual fiction.

In 2010 Naked Faces released its first theatrical feature, AARDVARK. Written and directed by Kitao Sakurai and produced by Andrew Barchilon, Aardvark premiered at the 63rd Locarno Film Festival where it won Special Mention for Best First Feature. Aardvark continues its competitive run in such festivals as AFI FEST, Rotterdam, Thessaloniki, the Viennale, BAFICI, Goteborg and others. Aardvark will have its European theatrical release in the first quarter of 2011 through distributor Aqueelarre. World sales are represented by FiGa Films. (figafilms.com)

In 2009 Kitao Sakurai served as director of photography and Andrew Barchilon as associate producer and production manager on Ry Russo-Young's Gotham Award-winning feature YOU WONT MISS ME. Having premiered at the Sundance Film Festival, YWMM will have its theatrical, DVD and VOD release through Factory 25 Films in late 2010. (youwontmissme.com)

After partnering with Argentine production company FILMY WIKTORA on the production of Aardvark, Naked Faces and FW have several upcoming feature projects in development and post-production. Upcoming is Argentine writer-director Gaston Solnicki's second feature MATEO OO, which will have its world premiere in mid 2011. (filmywiktora.com)

Naked Faces is now developing an episodic comedy show together with comedian Eric Andre called "Duh Air Ache On Dre Shoe." Co-hosted by 30 Rock / SNL writer Hannibal Buress, DAAODS is a 15-minute gonzo mock late night talk show.

Naked Faces also actively produces branded web content, music videos and TV promos. Most recently Naked Faces was commissioned by Levi's/Sub Rosa to create the online video campaign for the Levi's Photo Workshop in Manhattan. Other clients include the Parker Palm Springs Hotel, the Ace Hotel, Carlos Charlie Perez's "Contra" campaign for Vampire Weekend, as well as numerous music videos for Bad Boy Entertainment and Atlantic Records.
